LEAGUE PHILOSOPHY

The Central Illinois Youth Football League was organized to provide the youth of Champaign-Urbana and surrounding communities with an opportunity to play competitive full contact football in a supervised environment. DIVISIONS

Varsity — 7th & 8th grades

7th & 8th grade boys and girls who are, or will be at least twelve (12) but are not fifteen (15) years of age before September 1st of the current season.

Junior Varsity — 5th & 6th grades

5th & 6th grade boys and girls who are, or will be at least ten (10), but are not thirteen (13) years of age before September 1st of the current season.

Pee Wee — 3rd & 4th grades

3rd & 4th grade boys and girls who are, or will be at least eight (8), but are not eleven (11) years of age before September 1st of the current season.

WHAT IS EXPECTED

- Players MUST attend 3 or more practices per week to be ELIGIBLE to play on game days. If player is eligible, playing time is at the discretion of the coach.
- Parents will assist with Game Day functions.
- At least one parent will attend a Parent Meeting (new families only)
